Health Requirements

Early Childhood/Early Learning

- Must show proof of having a physical examination within one year of program entry.
- *Meet Illinois state immunization requirements*, this includes but is not limited to the following vaccines: hepatitis B series, at least one HIB after 15 months of age, chickenpox (varicella) and pneumococcal.

Kindergarten

- Physical exam within one year of school entry.
- Meets Illinois state immunization requirements.
- *Vision examination* to be completed by October 15 of school entry year.
- **Dental examination** required.

Second Grade

• **Dental examination** required.

Sixth Grade

- Physical examination completed within one year of school entrance into sixth grade. (Exam will meet sport physical requirement)
- Meets Illinois immunization requirements, this includes the Tdap, Hepatitis B series, Meningitis, and second Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine.
- Dental examination required.

Sports Physicals for students involved in interscholastic sports and/or cheerleading

- Sports physical exam within one year of try-outs on file in the Health Office.
- Students will not be allowed to participate in try-outs until physical exam submitted.

New students to the district

- Illinois students must show most recent physical examination and immunizations.
- Out-of-state students must meet Illinois immunization requirements prior to entrance by completing the Illinois Certificate of Examination form or an equivalent state form.
- Out of state students must have a vision examination completed prior to the entrance of school, using the State Of Illinois Eye Examination Report completed by an ophthalmologist/optometrist.
- **Dental** requirements apply to K, 2 and 6 graders using the Proof of School Dental Examination form.

Mobile Dental/Orthodontic Yearly Screening Clinic

- **Mobile dental** services are available for all district students who return the packet to be sent home with students.
- An orthodontic screening will also be available for 3st through 8st grades during the mobile clinic.

~Incomplete physicals will not be accepted. Physicals must include: Parent signature, required immunizations, lead screen, diabetic screen, vital signs, height, weight, BMI, MD signature and address and phone, and exam date.
